

FLORA ROADS

A Flora Road is one that has special conservation value because of the vegetation contained within the road reserve. There are currently no designated Flora Roads in the Shire of Boyup Brook. The roadside survey and the 2013 RCV map highlight a number of roadsides which have the potential to be declared Flora Roads. Some of the roadsides determined as having high conservation value in the Shire include:

- Distributor Road
- Falnash Road
- Greenfields Road
- Lower Blackwood Road
 - Nollajup Road
 - Terrace Road
- Wingebellup Road
- Woodinbillup Road



Roads with large sections of high conservation value vegetation can also become Flora Roads. In some cases these roads can be targets for revegetation work to close the gap between the sections of conservation value.



Some more of these roadsides in the Shire of Boyup Brook are:

- Boyup Brook-Cranbrook Road
- North Boyup Brook Road
 - Camballan Road
 - Chambers Road
 - Condinup Road
 - Cootayarup Road
 - Eulin Crossing Road

FLORA ROADS

Many of the rural roads have long tracts of bush with good displays of wildflowers. Those named on this map are of special interest.

GREEN AREAS ARE OFFICIAL NATURE RESERVES WHERE STRICTLY:

- NO DOGS are permitted within the boundaries
- NO VEHICLES may enter
- NO PLANTS OR PART THERE-OF may be taken
- NO FIRES may be lit
- ALL RUBBISH must be taken with you

DIEBACK DISEASE IS AN ISSUE

Make sure your footwear is cleaned before entering and after leaving any and every area of bush. A small scrubbing brush to remove any soil and a spray bottle of methylated spirits will achieve this.

Nollajup Nature Reserve - A large reserve on the corner of Brown Seymore Road and Jayes Road.

Reservoir Road Water Catchment Area - A very large area servicing the old town dam. Lots to see, both sides of the road

Six Mile Road Nature Reserve - One of the smaller reserves but well endowed with wild flowers.

Mayanup Crown Land - a large tract from the end of the Mayanup Sports Ground and along the Cranbrook Road.

Wahkinup Nature Reserve - Junction of Wahkinup Road and Lower Blackwood Road

Nth Kulikup Nature Reserve - along the Kulikup North Road between Red Hill Road and Balgarup Road.

Tonebridge - Go past the picnic area and turn left at Terrace Road.
