## BOYUP BROOK FLAX MILL MUSEUM & CARAVAN PARK

The Flax Mill site is a significant part of Boyup Brook's history as the production of ropes and webbing from flax grown in the district was an important industry in operation during World War II. Of all of the Flax mills established through out Australia it is the only one partly still standing & has been developed as a recreation and accommodation precinct.
