Rosman Family.

Roy and Elizabeth Rosman moved from Geraldton in the 1920's to take up a Group Settlement on Pump Hill Road. There were seven children. Joyce, the youngest, was born in Pemberton. Nearly all the boys, Noel, Dave, Ray, Lloyd, Lossi and Allen, worked in the timber industry. David and Lossi enlisted in the armed forces during the second world war. The rest were manpowered and were required to continue working in the Pemberton Mill due to the importance of timber in the war effort.

Noel Rosman married Moira MacArthur from Jardee in 1941. There is a fabulous story told of their courtship about how Noel would ride on his pushbike all the way to Jardee from Thomsons Hill to pick up Moira to go to the local dance in Pemberton. She was said to ride on the crossbars of his bike there and back. What a feat! Moira died in 2020.

The name of Rosman is well respected in the community.
